



Pacific Northwest Numismatic Association Scholarship Program for ANA Tukwila Seminar—April 2020 Scholarship Application

The PNNA is offering two full \$250 scholarships to attend the ANA's "Counterfeit Detection Seminar: Classic Fakes & Chinese-made Counterfeits," April 15-16, 2020 in Tukwila, Wash., prior to the PNNA spring convention in Tukwila. These scholarships may be awarded to either Adult or YN (Young Numismatist ages 13 to 17) collectors/dealers. Awarding of scholarships is contingent upon qualified applicants and having enough registrants to hold the seminar. In the event that the seminar is cancelled, no scholarships will be awarded. Scholarships cover only the ANA/PNNA member registration fee of \$250, and not travel or other expenses.

The last day to register with the ANA is **March 6, 2020**. If you want your registration processed only if you win a scholarship (i.e., you don't want to pay the fee yourself), please let us know. It will not affect decisions about scholarship awards.

The winners will be Adult or YN collectors/dealers who are PNNA members, complete this application and are selected by the awards committee. *If you are not a current member of the PNNA – please submit \$10.00 dues with the application (\$5.00 YN dues). Please add \$5.00 to each dues classification if you want the PNNA's quarterly newsletter (The Nor'wester) mailed.* Deadline for receipt of applications will be **February 22, 2020**.
