IMPORTANT: Requirements for this Merit Badge were changed effective 2024.

Be sure you prepare for the current requirements!

The new requirements are only numbered 1-7, the old were numbered 1-10.

BEFORE THE WORKSHOP ...

1. Be familiar with the "Coin Collecting" merit badge pamphlet. At the workshop, Scouts will review the requirements.
2. Collect and bring with you the sixteen coins required by requirement 4.
 - 1: a 1¢ coin dated 1959-2008
 - 2: a 1¢ coin dated 2010-present
 - 3: a 5¢ coin dated 1959- 2003
 - 4: a 5¢ coin dated 2006-present
 - 5: a 10¢ coin dated 1965-present
 - 6: a quarter (25¢ coin) dated 1965-1998
 - 7-8: two quarters from the 50-State Quarter/Territories Program 1999-2009
 - 9-10: two quarters from the America the Beautiful program 2012-2021
 - 11-12: two quarters from the American Woman Quarter program 2022-present
 - 13: a half-dollar (50¢) coin from 1965-present
 - 14: a Susan B. Anthony dollar coin 1979-99
 - 15: a Sacagawea dollar coin 1990-2005
 - 16: a U.S. Presidents dollar coin 2000-2014

AT THE WORKSHOP ...

Everyone will learn a lot about collecting U.S. coins. Scouts will complete the other requirements during the workshop. Scouts that come prepared (per "before the workshop" above) will complete all requirements and finish their blue cards, others will leave with a partial and can finish later. Parents and adult leaders are welcome and encouraged to attend. Check-in begins 30 minutes before the workshop; please arrive early

enough to check-in at least 15 minutes early. We encourage you to allow ample time before or after the workshop to explore the coin show. The coin show is open 10am – 6pm on Saturday (and on Friday 12noon – 7pm, Sunday 10am-4pm).

SCOUTMASTERS ...

Please provide Scouts with signed Merit Badge Cards and ask them to complete all personal information (name, address, etc.). Certified Merit Badge Counselor(s) will be leading the workshop and will sign the cards upon completion of the requirements. Remind your Scouts to bring note pads and pencils, and their collected coins for requirement 4. Remind Scouts to wear their uniforms. Scoutmasters should provide a copy of this flyer to Scouts planning to attend the workshop so they can be prepared.

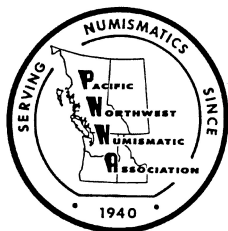
PARKING OPTIONS ...
